FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION

Tuition rates for the 2018-2019 School Year are shown below. There is a little over two percent increase for all tuition rates for the SY1819 school year. Registration is \$150 per student (non-refundable) and \$50 per family for Raffle Fee (tickets). The Family fee remains the same and the Student Fee has been increased to \$160 per student. The Graduation Fee is \$75 per 7th and 8th grade students only.

| To qualify for a Parish Rate, a family must have a minimum of 6 months participation in the Parish community and must contribute to the Parish using registered donation envelopes. | | | | | |
| The first monthly payment is due on July 31, 2018. The nine remaining monthly payments are due in the middle of each month from September-May and are paid one month in advance. All billings include due and late fee dates. Checks returned NSF will incur a bank fee of \$35. Late payments will incur a late fee of \$25. | | | | | |

| Festival | Every family will be given one book of 50 Festival Raffle tickets. A separate check must be made out to St. Bridget of Sweden School in the amount of \$50. You may sell your raffle tickets, or you may turn them in with your name on them. In addition, every family is required to work a minimum of 14 volunteer hours during the Festival. <i>Payment for raffle tickets is due in the spring of the previous school year.</i> | | | \$50 per family | |
| Fundraising | Every family is required to participate in the yearly fundraising activities for the school and makes a fundraising commitment of \$150. In previous years, this fundraising commitment has been a chocolate sale. Other opportunities are always explored. The financial commitment remains unchanged. | | | \$150 per family | |
| Service Hours | Every family is required to complete 40 hours of service to the school, at least 14 of which must be completed at the Fall Festival. Any uncompleted festival hours will be billed at a rate of \$75 per hour. All other incomplete hours will be billed at a rate of \$15 per hour. | | | | |
| Parent Meeting Credit | Families will receive \$50 tuition credit and 5 service hours after they have attended 3 qualifying Parent Meetings. | | | | |
| Prepayment Credit | Families who pay the full annual tuition by July 31, 2018 will receive a \$100 tuition credit. | | | | |
